Entry Fees: \$25 per class
ABRA Add-on \$100 flat fee per mule - \$25 for 2 & Under (4 judge show)

ENTRY DEADLINE - June 20, 2026, Post Entries add \$5/class
 NASMDA FEE: \$3.00/animal, Office fee: \$25.00 per animal

Camping Hookups are available for \$30/night. Reservations are required to ensure availability.

Stakes Classes (Classes 50, 51, 52): \$50 Entry Fee (\$25 Towards the Jackpot) Jackpot will be 40% - 30% - 20% - 10%

Stakes Classes Do Not Count Towards High Points

Stalls \$25/night. One animal per stall only. Verify with show management availability for early arrivals.
Grounds Fee \$15/equine per day (if no stall) This includes non-show days. NO OVERNIGHT TIE-OUTS!
Stalls assigned by seniority, then first-come, first-served basis. Please notify show management of any jacks.

Shavings available onsite for \$10/bag.

NASMDA membership and registration papers REQUIRED for all NASMDA Classes.

ABRA Membership and Registration required for eligibility in ABRA classes.

Non-NASMDA classes do not have a membership or registration requirement.

Amateur exhibitors must have current NASMDA Amateur card & show an animal NASMDA registered or leased in their name.

All junior mules (5 & Under) must have mouthing certificate or NASMDA registration papers.

Youth 10 & Under must show either a mule or donkey and all associated classes are walk/trot only.

Rules for classes 48, 60, & 116 only:

- Walk trot mule/rider combo entries are restricted from cross-entering into any lope class. The mule may enter a lope class with a different rider, or the rider may enter a lope class with a different mule.
- A 10 & Under rider may not enter these classes, as per NASMDA Rule 138-G.
- Equipment rules and class procedures will follow the NASMDA rulebook.
- Walk Trot Western Pleasure will follow Rule 168.
- Walk Trot Ranch Rail will follow Rule 174, with the exception of requiring a lope or extended lope.
- Walk Trot Mulemanship will follow Rule 169, with the exception of requiring a lope.
- *Note a rail portion may be required, so a rider may not enter multiple mules in this class.
