To the NASMA Officers & BOD:

A quick update from the Registrar's Desk –

2007 marked renewed enthusiasm for NASMA with 55 new registrations and 30 transfers. \$2105 was generated and expenses were \$417 for a net income of \$1688.

Debbie Brewer took over as the official Points Keeper and has done a tremendous job in automating, posting results and doing the overall achievement awards.

There are still some housekeeping items that need to be addressed by Rule Book changes and I will have a draft submitted by the March deadline.

Online registrations were tested in 2007, but not officially adopted for a several reasons – actual signatures must still be obtained for many portions of the registration (breeder's certificate, farm name authorization, etc.) and PayPal notification to the Registrar has not been ironed out.

Members are now able to query the database when selecting a name for their animal.

I am still relying on my husband to print the registrations at his place of work, but have had several instances where this was not feasible and have had to use Office Depot (at \$2/registration and the nearest one is 50 miles away!) 2008 will probably herald the purchase of a laser printer for NASMA to keep the professional quality documents that we have generated in the past.
